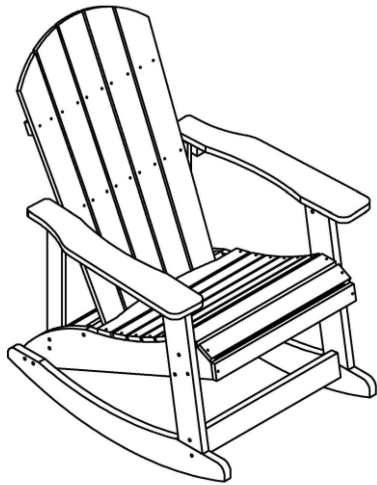

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

### **Before You Begin:**

Please identify all component parts and hardware pieces required before you begin. Carefully remove all of the components from the packaging and set aside for assembly. Assemble on a soft surface to prevent scratching during assembly.











This warranty covers manufacturing defects associated with your new product. The product is warranted from the original purchase date and to the original purchaser for normal usage, according to the below-referenced specifications and limitations.

- Non-moving metal parts are warranted for 5 years.
- Component parts including pneumatic cylinder, control mechanism, base and casters are warranted for 2 years.
- All other items are warranted for 1 year.

Normal usage means use in compliance with the restrictions and weight limits specified for the product. In the absence of product-specific restrictions and weight limits, normal usage means use for no more than forty hours per week by persons weighing 250 lbs. or less. Coverage terminates if the product is sold or otherwise transferred. Repairs made by parties other than Belnick also void this warranty.

This warranty will not cover: (1) labor, freight, or damage from misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, assembly, installation, attachments, accident, vandalism, acts of nature or any other event beyond the control of Belnick; (2) tearing, scratching, scuffing, or blemishing of leather or fabric; (3) cosmetic damage that may result from normal usage; (4) damage attributable to use by persons exceeding specified weight limits or commercial use exceeding forty hours per week; or (5) rust or other damage caused by exposure to moisture. 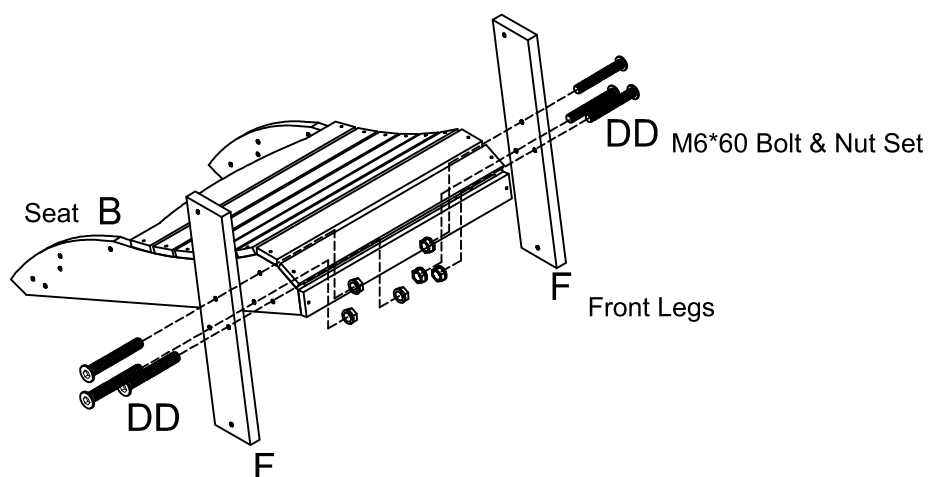
## STEP 1

**STEP 1:** Attach the Rear Seat Slat (Part H) to the Seat (Part B) using (2) 4\*35 Screws (Part AA). Tighten using a Phillips screwdriver.



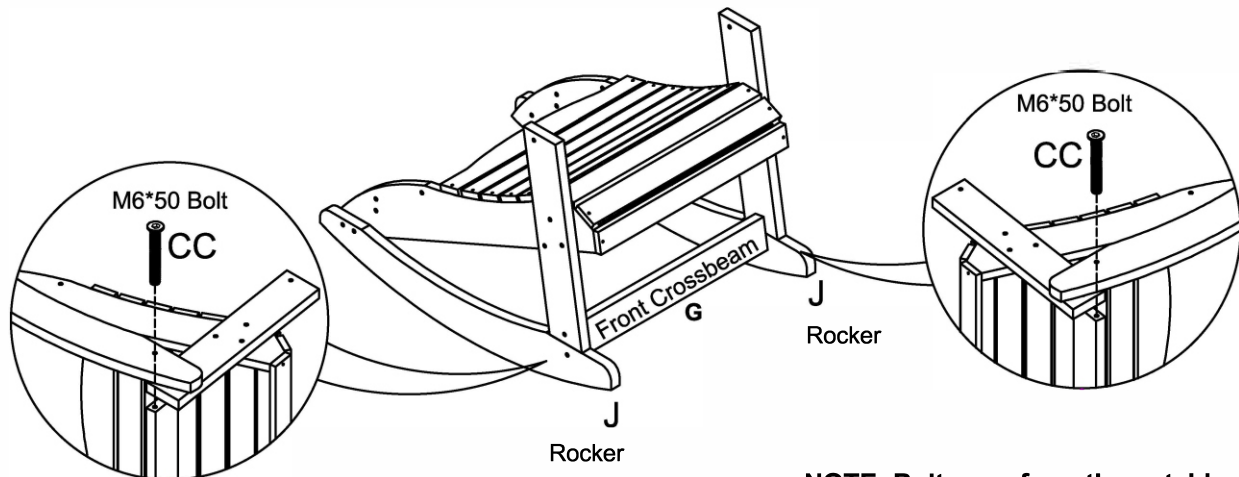
## STEP 2

**STEP 2:** Attach the Front Legs (Part F) to the Seat (Part B) using (6) M6\*60 Bolt and Nut Sets (Part DD). Hand tighten bolts.



### STEP 3

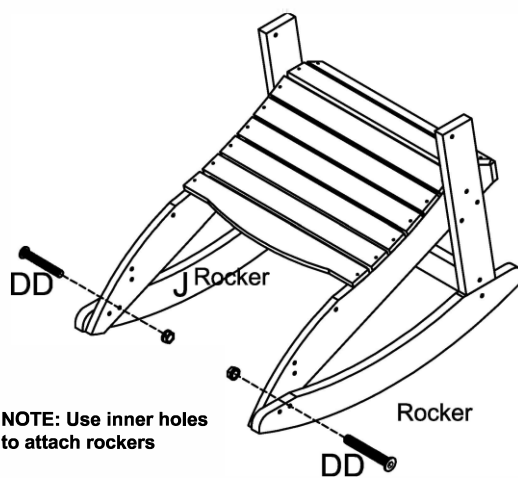
**STEP 3:** Attach the Rockers (Part J) and Front Crossbeam (Part G) to the Front Legs (Part F) using (2) M6\*50 Bolts (CC) then hand tighten.



**NOTE:** Bolt goes from the outside through the Rocker and Front Leg then into Crossbeam.

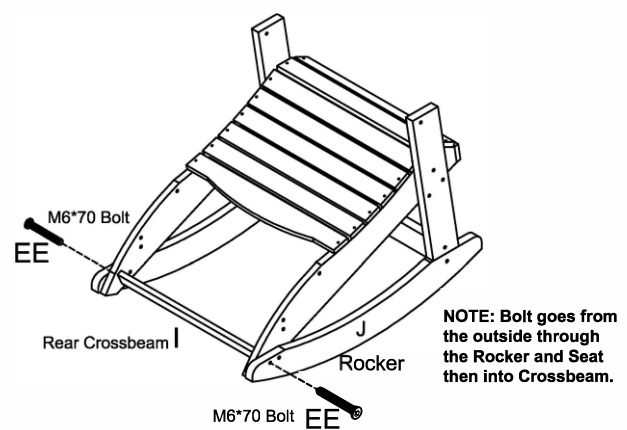
### STEP 4A & 4B

**STEP 4A:** Attach the Rockers (Part J) to the Seat (Part B) using (2) M6\*60 Bolt and Nut Sets (Part DD) then hand tighten.



**NOTE:** Use inner holes to attach rockers

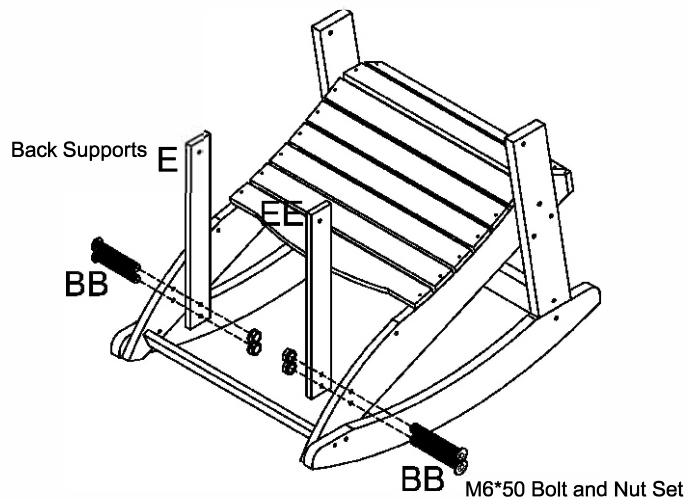
**STEP 4B:** Attach Rear Crossbeam (Part I) to the Seat (Part B) and Rockers (Part J) using (2) M6\*70 Bolts (Part EE) then hand tighten.



**NOTE:** Bolt goes from the outside through the Rocker and Seat then into Crossbeam.

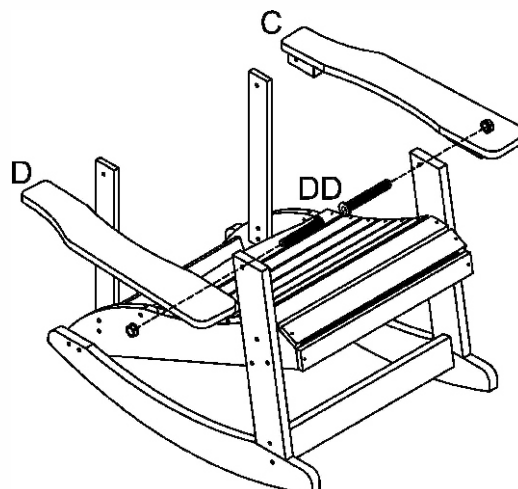
## STEP 5

**STEP 5:** Attach the Back Supports (Part E) to the Seat (Part B) using (4) M6\*50 Bolt and Nut Sets (Part BB) then hand tighten.



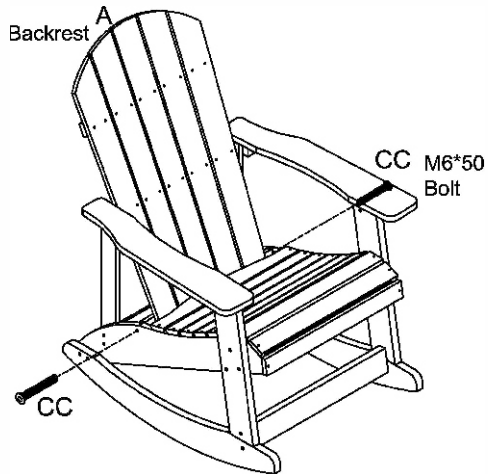
## STEP 6

**STEP 6:** Attach the front of the Left Armrest (Part C) and Right Armrest (Part D) to the Front Legs (Part F) using (2) M6\*60 Bolt and Nut Sets (Part DD) then hand tighten.

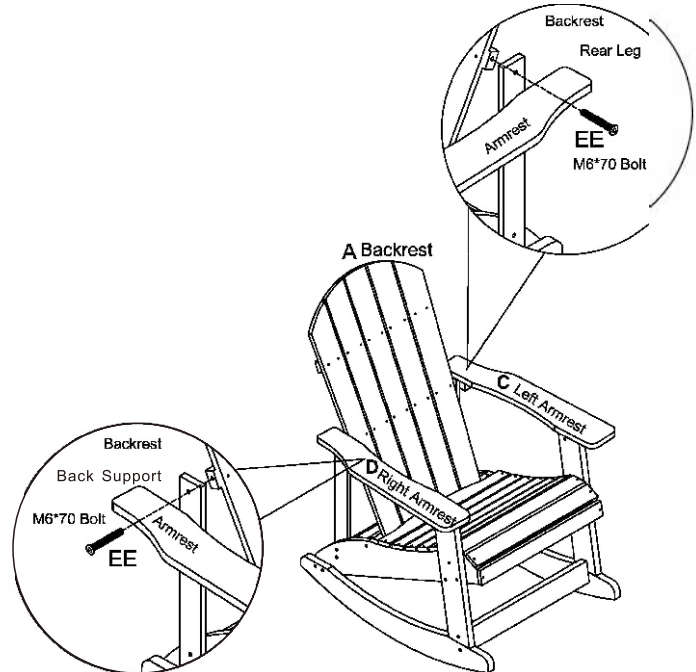


## STEP 7A & 7B

**STEP 7A:** Attach the bottom of the Backrest (Part A) to the Seat (Part B) using (2) M6\*50 Bolts (Part CC).

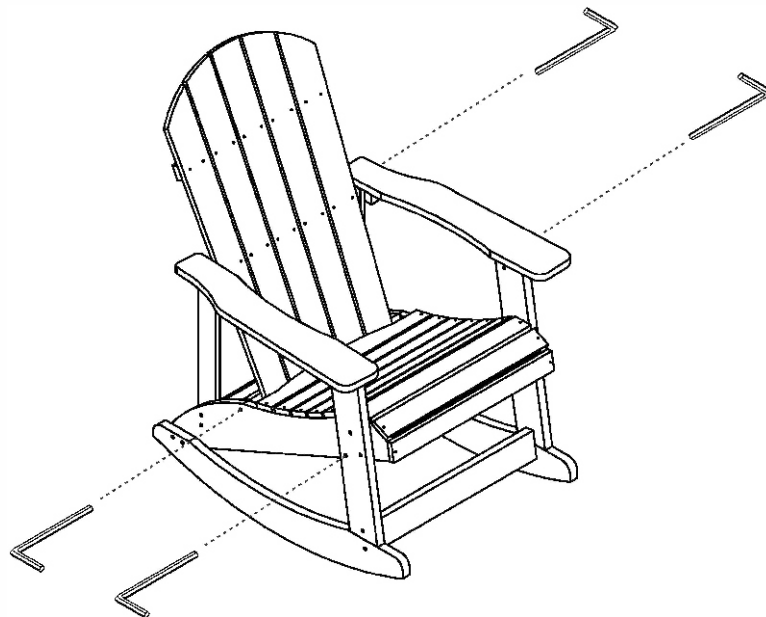


**STEP 7B:** Attach the rear of the Left Armrest (Part C) and Right Armrest (Part D) to the Back Supports (Part E) and Backrest (Part A) using (2) M6\*70 Bolts (Part EE).

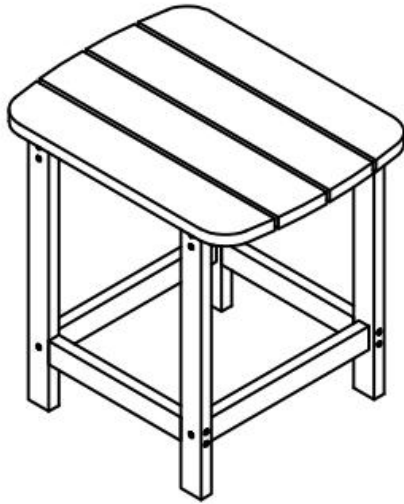


## STEP 8

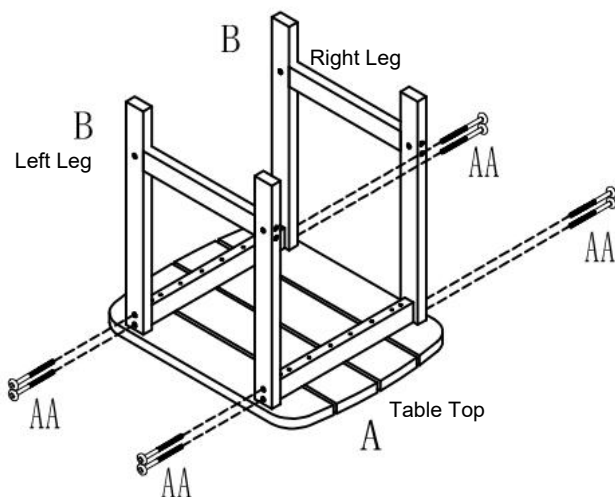
